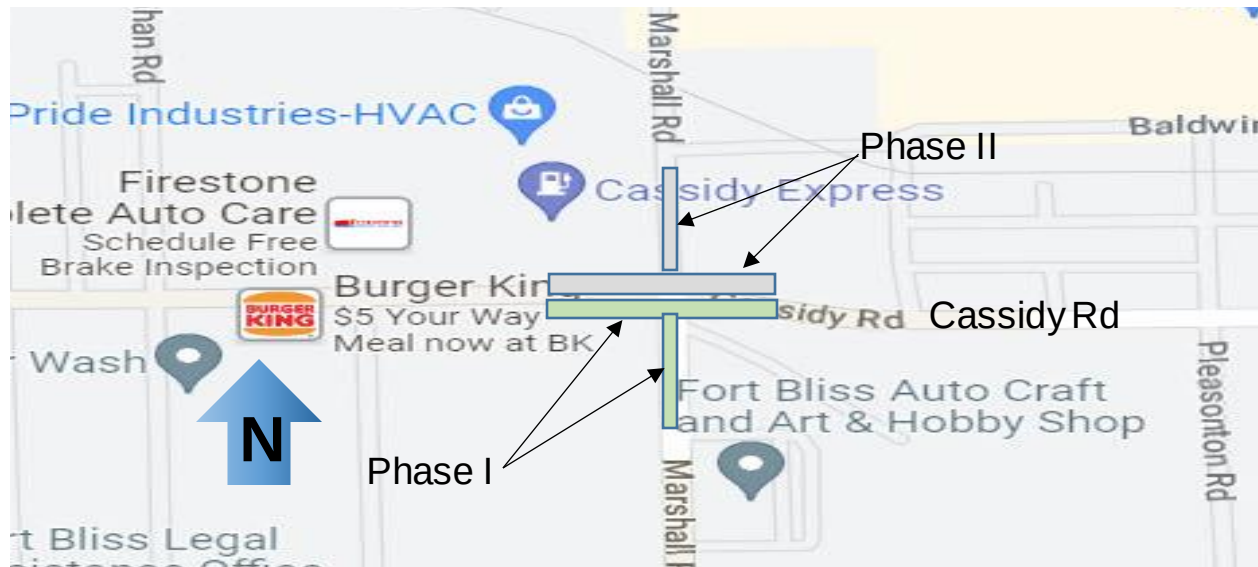

➤ Cassidy and Marshall Intersection Paving Repairs

- Due to unforeseen existing utility lines, Corps of Engineers will not be able to complete the project as designed. The Contractor will be allowed to complete a full utility survey, restore the pavement to its original condition, and reopen the intersection on all directions.
- Phase I lanes to be reopened tentatively 3rd week of October 2023. Phase II lanes will be closed tentatively once other lanes are opened.
- Estimated Time for Project Completion: January 2024

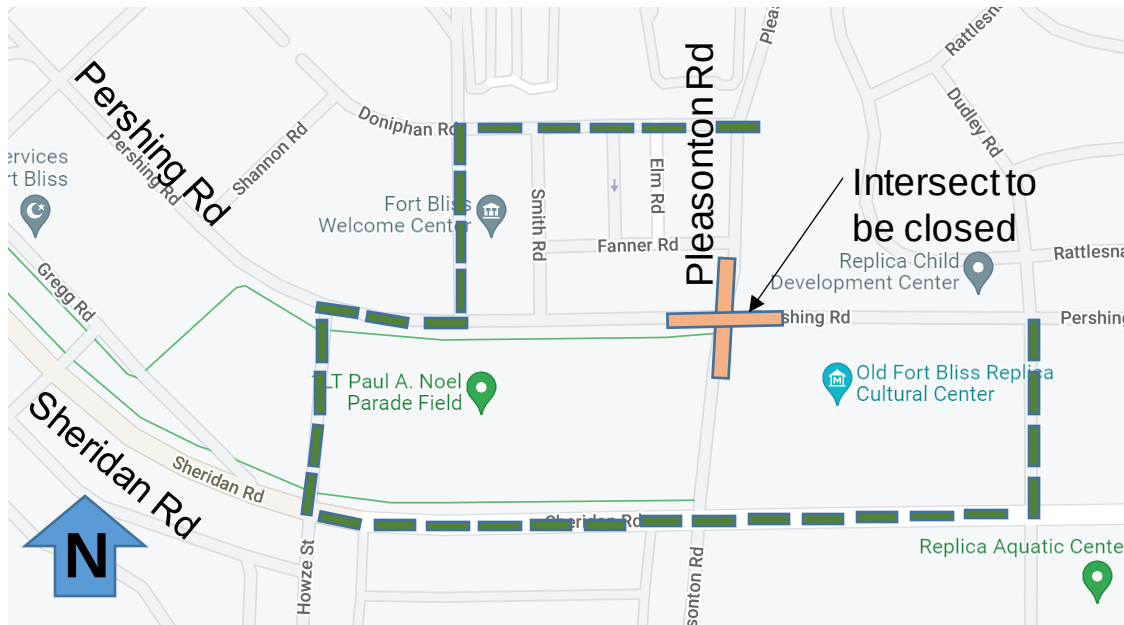

➤ Water Mitigation at Pershing & Pleasonton Intersection

- Construction started: 21 Dec 2022
- Intersection is currently closed during construction.
- Completion Date Update: **30 Nov 2023 (no change)**

Road Repair Update

➤ **New Tire Spikes at eleven Access Control Points (ACPs) per Directorate of Emergency Services (DES)**

- Project includes the following ACPs: Cassidy, Sheridan, Chaffee, Buffalo Soldier, Pena, Old Ironsides, Constitution, Barrera, Minue, Espinoza, & Duran
- One outbound lane will always remain open during construction
- Lanes will be closed for a couple of hours and reopen the same day
- Tentative Construction award date: 30 September 2023
- Tentative start date: November 2023. Awaiting for notice to proceed
- Completion date: TBD

Law Enforcement Focus Area

- **Increased Traffic Enforcement:**
- **Halloween Safety.** PSD reminds everyone that during trick-or-treat activities:
 - Children should wear light clothing/costumes and/or wear reflective material on their person.
 - Street crossings should be done at intersections.
 - Children should watch for cars turning at intersections or into/out of driveways.
 - Children should be escorted by an adult.
 - Electronic devices should not be a focus when walking.
 - Avoid unlit areas in the dark.
 - Only approach homes with door lights on or that have obvious Halloween activities occurring.
 - All candy collected should be inspected by an adult before consumption.
- PSD is also heavily focused on enforcing the Non-Tactical Vehicles (NTV) prohibition on tank trails. It is a violation of FB Reg 27-5 and Texas Transportation Code 544.004 (Failing to Comply With a Traffic Control Device) and is a focus area of attention by the Commanding General.
- All patrons entering through ACPs on Fort Bliss must adhere to stop signs and wait until called forward by ACP personnel to ensure safety and security at ACPs.
- A reminder of prohibited items/acts IAW FB Reg 27-5 June 2023:
 - **Unlawful Possession of Firearms** (carrying to go armed/improper transportation)
 - **Concealed Carry of Firearms** (not authorized w/o Senior Commander approval)
 - **Unregistered Firearms** (24 hours to register firearms on-post)
 - **Improper Storage of Firearms** (not authorized in barracks)
 - **Prohibited Weapons/Items** (Silencer; switchblade; knives w/blades over 5 ½ inches; swords; knuckles; stun guns/tasers; over 4 ounces of pepper/OC spray; armor piercing ammunition; fireworks)

- HELMET WILL BE WORN by all Soldiers, DoD Civilians, Contractors, and Family members who operate or intend to operate bicycles or recreational vehicles within Fort Bliss.
- Bicycles and recreational play vehicles (inline skates, roller skates, scooters, skateboards, etc.)

- **Garrison Policy 24, para 4(d)(6)**

- LEASHES: Dogs must be completely under control at all times in public areas. (exception for dog parks)
- Pets must not be left tied and unattended, or leashed and allowed to roam freely anywhere outside of a fenced area.
